HTML Skeleton

← All HTML5 files start with this. <!DOCTYPE html> ← The first tag of every HTML page. < html><head> ← Open the head tag ← This is the title that shows up in the browser tab. <title></title> </head> ← Close the head tag. <body> ← Open the body. Contains everything visible to user. </body> ← Close the body. </html> ← Close your HTML.



An HTML element is a piece of code in html, including a tag, content, and attributes:

This is a link to Google.com

Container elements hold text inside of them:

```
This is text inside the paragraph.
```

Empty elements do not, they are self-closing:

HTML5 Tag Reference

← Paragraph tag. Contains text. > ← Used for *emphasizing* text. ← Used for **important** keywords.
 ← Adds a line break. ← "Anchor" tag, used to link to other websites. Needs "href" attribute. <a> ← Image tag. Needs "src" and "alt" attributes. < imq />← Unordered list tag. Contains <1i> tags. <l ← Ordered list tag. Contains <1i> tags. <01> ← Table tag. Contains <thead>, >, , >, and td> tags. <!-- This is an HTML comment! -->

- Nest your elements with indented space.
